- Minimum of six (6) years' experience directly related to carpentry.
- Two (2) years' experience working with Indigenous populations preferably in a learning environment
- Strong building and construction skills.

- Sensitivity to the diversity, socioeconomic, cultural and risk factors of at-risk youth.
