The YouthBuild Teacher will possess the necessary skills to assist students in becoming successful learners. These include knowledge of respective disciplines, the use of learning technologies, the creation of an effective learning environment, interpersonal skills, and knowledge of how adolescents and adults learn. The position includes teaching English, First Nations and Inuit History, Career Development, and team teaching in Math.

The successful candidate will possess:

- A Bachelor's degree in education, with a major in English Language Arts
- Experience in literacy required
- Experience with adult learners required
- Experience with Indigenous students in a post-secondary environment preferred
- Experience in administrative work including usage of various technology tools
- Demonstrates sensitivity to the needs and issues of Indigenous students
- Ability to work well under pressure
